

IENOVA ANNOUNCES THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH PEMEX GAS Y PETROQUÍMICA BÁSICA FOR THE DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE LOS RAMONES I PIPELINE.

México, D.F., July 19, 2013 – Infraestructura Energética Nova, S.A.B. de C.V. "<u>IEnova</u>", informs that today, through a subsidiary of Gasoductos de Chihuahua, S. de R.L. de C.V. "<u>GdC</u>", it entered into an agreement with Pemex Gas y Petroquímica Básica "<u>PGPB</u>", to provide firm natural gas transportation services, for a term of 25 years, with respect to one hundred percent of the transport capacity of the pipeline known as Los Ramones I.

The Los Ramones I pipeline project is a natural gas transportation system with a length of approximately 114 km, a diameter of 48" and a transportation capacity, in its final phase, of 2.1 Bcfd. The route will start at the border with the United States, at a point located near the city of Camargo, Tamaulipas and will end in Los Ramones, Nuevo León. The transportation system will interconnect from the point of origin at the U.S. border with the pipeline "Agua Dulce-Frontera" and will terminate at an interconnection point with the Los Ramones II pipeline, a proposed project of 740 km length and 42" diameter.

GdC is the joint venture between IEnova and PGPB, which has successfully developed energy infrastructure in the country. The Los Ramones I pipeline project represents the first phase of one of the most important natural gas transportation projects that has been conceived in recent years, in order to supply natural gas to the North and Center of the country.
