

**IENOVA ANNOUNCES THE EXECUTION OF THE FIRST LONG-TERM  
ELECTRIC SUPPLY CONTRACT BETWEEN A PRIVATE GENERATOR AND  
AN INDUSTRIAL CLIENT IN MEXICO**

Mexico City, March 27, 2017 – Infraestructura Energética Nova, S.A.B. de C.V. “IEnova” announced today that its subsidiary ESJ Renovable II, S. de R.L. de C.V. executed a 20-year electric supply contract with Deacero, S.A.P.I. de C.V. to provide them energy, clean energy certificates, and capacity from a new solar power plant located in Caborca, Sonora.

The Company will develop, construct, and operate the 110 MW Pima Solar project, which has a total investment of \$115 million. The estimated commercial operations date is the fourth quarter of 2018.

IEnova will be responsible for all aspects of project implementation, including permitting, land and rights of way acquisition, engineering, procurement, construction, financing, operations, and maintenance.

This initiative is aligned with IEnova’s firm commitment to the development of projects that contribute to achieving Mexico’s renewable energy goals.
