IENOVA ANNOUNCES THE ENTERINGO INTO CERTAIN WIND TURBINES SUPPLY AGREEMENT

Mexico City - Infraestructura Energética Nova, S.A.B. de C.V., "**IEnova**" reports that as part of the implementation of the project Energía Sierra Juárez, for the development of the first phase of approximately 155.1 MW, of a wind farm with a projected capacity of up to 1,200 MW in the mountain range known as Sierra de Juarez in the state of Baja California Sierra, its subsidiaries Energía Sierra Juárez, S. de R.L. de C.V. ("**ESJ**"), ESJ Turbinas, S. de R.L. de C.V. ("**ESJ Turbinas**") and ESJ Turbinas II, S. de R.L. de C.V. ("**ESJ Turbinas II**"), entered into with Vestas WTG México, S.A. de C.V. ("**Vestas**"), a Wind Turbine Supply and Warranty Agreement (the "**Supply Agreement**"), pursuant to which, among other things, the parties agreed that: (i) ESJ, ESJ Turbinas and ESJ Turbinas II, will jointly acquire from Vestas, 47 wind turbines, as well as the option to acquire five more wind turbines, (ii) IEnova will act as guarantor of the obligations of ESJ, ESJ Turbinas and ESJ Turbinas II under the Supply Agreement and (iii) Vestas will render to ESJ maintenance services for the wind turbines.
