

**IENOVA ANNOUNCES THE START OF THE AUTHORIZATION PROCESS IN
RELATION TO A POTENTIAL ACQUISITION OF THE PARTICIPATION OF
SAAVI ENERGÍA IN ENERGÍA SIERRA JUÁREZ**

Mexico City, January 8, 2021 - Infraestructura Energética Nova, S.A.B. de C.V. (“**IEnova**”) informs that today, Energía Sierra Juárez U.S., LLC and y Energía Sierra Juárez U.S., Transmission, LLC, subsidiaries of Energía Sierra Juárez, S. de R.L. de C.V. (“**Energía Sierra Juárez**”), filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission of the United States of America (“**FERC**”) in relation to the potential acquisition by IEnova, through its subsidiary Controladora Sierra Juárez, S. de RL de C.V., of the ownership that Saavi Energía, through its affiliates Cometa Energía, S.A. de C.V., and Saavi Energía (UK) Ltd (“**Saavi**”), holds in Energía Sierra Juárez.

The effects of the purchase and sale agreement of this potential acquisition by IEnova are subject to the fulfillment of various conditions precedent. In the event that the purchase and sale agreement takes effect, the closing of said acquisition will be subject to the fulfillment of customary closing conditions for this type of operation, including obtaining authorization from the FERC and the Mexican Antitrust Commission.

Energía Sierra Juárez, a 50-50 joint venture between IEnova and Saavi Energía, is a wind generation complex located in the Municipality of Tecate, Baja California, Mexico. The first phase is an operating wind project that has an installed capacity of 155 megawatts. The second phase is under development and will have an installed capacity of 108 megawatts.
