



IENOVA ANNOUNCES THE EXECUTION OF A NATURAL GAS TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH COMISIÓN FEDERAL DE ELECTRICIDAD FOR THE SOUTH TEXAS – TUXPAN PIPELINE.

Mexico City, June 17, 2016 – Infraestructura Energética Nova, S.A.B. de C.V., "<u>IEnova</u>" informs that, through Infraestructura Marina del Golfo, S. de R.L. ("<u>IMG</u>") de C.V., the joint venture formed between IEnova and TransCanada Corporation ("<u>TransCanada</u>"), whereby IEnova holds 40% and TransCanada 60%, entered into a 25-year natural gas transportation services agreement with the Comisión Federal de Electricidad ("<u>CFE</u>"), in connection with the bid issued by CFE for the South Texas – Tuxpan pipeline.

IMG shall be responsible for the development, construction, and operation of the 42-inch pipeline that has a capacity of 2.6 BCF (billion cubic feet per day) and a length of approximately 800 km. The project will require an investment of US \$2.1 billion and is expected to begin operations in the last quarter of 2018.

This initiative is consistent with IEnova's strong commitment to the development of infrastructure in Mexico.
