



MOODY'S ANNUNCEMENT ON RECALIBRATION OF MEXICO'S NATIONAL QUALIFICATION'S SCALE

Mexico City, June 14, 2016 – Infraestructura Energética Nova, S.A.B. de C.V., ("<u>IEnova</u>"), informs that yesterday, the credit rating agency Moody's de México, S.A. de C.V. ("<u>Moody's</u>"), published a press release in which, among other things, it announced a change in its methodology, a repositioning of the National Scale Ratings ("<u>NSR</u>"), and the recalibration of the National Scale Ratings for Mexico.

Pursuant to Moody's press release, the adjustment was made to reflect the distribution of the fundamental qualifications in the country and that about 20% of the main NSR of the fundamental Mexican issuers are being repositioned lower, by an average of a step.

As a consequence of said recalibration, and not related to IEnova's performance, IEnova's National Scale rating was adjusted to Aa1.mx from Aaa.mx.

Notwithstanding the foregoing recalibration, IEnova's Global Scale remains unchanged at Baa1, which reflects the solid credit quality of IEnova.
