

**IENOVA ANNOUNCES AGREEMENT WITH INTERGEN FOR THE SALE OF
50 PERCENT OF THE FIRST PHASE OF ENERGÍA SIERRA JUÁREZ WIND
PROJECT.**

México, D.F., April 21, 2014 – Infraestructura Energética Nova, S.A.B. de C.V. “**IEnova**”, in connection with the project known as Energía Sierra Juárez, hereby informs the following:

- (i) On April 18, 2014, through its subsidiary Controladora Sierra Juárez, S. de R.L. de C.V., entered with InterGen into a purchase agreement with respect to the 50% of the membership interests (*partes sociales*) representative of the capital stock of Energía Sierra Juárez, S. de R.L. de C.V., its subsidiary in charge of developing the first phase of the wind generation project named “Energía Sierra Juárez”.
- (ii) The transaction is subject to obtaining the corresponding approvals from the regulatory authorities in Mexico and the United States of America.
- (iii) The Energía Sierra Juárez project is located in the Municipality of Tecate, Baja California, Mexico. The development of the first phase will require an investment of approximately US\$300 million and will generate 155 megawatt (“MW”) of wind energy through 47, 3.3-MW Vestas turbines. The first phase starts operations during the first half of 2015. Expected to come on-line during the first half of 2015, Energía Sierra Juárez has a 20 year power purchase agreement with San Diego Gas & Electric. Energía Sierra Juárez is the first cross-border wind-generation project between Mexico and the U.S.
